# Educational and Training Vouchers For Current and Former Foster Care Youth

Need help paying for college or career and technical education?

## What are Educational and Training Vouchers?

ETVs are grants awarded to eligible current and former foster youth to help pay for college and career or technical school.

## Am I eligible?

The ETV Program Helps

- Youth 16 to 21 who are currently in foster care;
- Young people 16 to 21 who were adopted or entered relative guardianship assistance program at age 16 or older; and
- Young people ages 18 - 21 who left foster care or community placement after turning 18

You must:

- Have your high school diploma or GED
- Have applied to or be enrolled or attending school

## How much is it?

Up to \$5,000 per academic year based on cost of attendance and available funds.
